



September 18th - 24th is National Rehabilitation Awareness Week, this celebrates the power of rehabilitation which enables those to overcome injuries or illness by living life to the fullest. Reflecting on those overcoming physical challenges, I think of the tenants of D.A.R.E. Apartments. Last month we took a trip to

Brookfield Zoo. As I watched mother's in their wheelchairs interacting with their children, I saw courage, perseverance, and most of all Love. Later in the week as I shared my experience with one of our tenants, Ms. Lois Anderson, she began expressing her many difficulties rearing children with disabilities.



Ms. Anderson's life took a drastic change on July 27, 1972, when she was accidentally shot. She remembers hearing the doctors say that she would not live. She began crying and praying to live for her children ages 7-10 not to be without a mother. Her prayers were answered, however this tragedy left her a paraplegic. She would spent 5 months in the hospital and 4 1/2 months in Rehabilitation. Upon returning home, with assistance with family and friends, she made a huge chart for each child chore's so that the household could run somewhat smoother.

In the 70's Disability Services were very limited, however in 1974 the Disability Act was passed, which provided services of Personal Care Attendants, Transportation, and more establishments with more wheelchair accessibility.

During this time of many obstacles, Ms. Anderson kept her faith and the quotes from "God grand me the Serenity". Her children through their endurance made great achievements. Her son Derrick went to the Marine Core, Steve, Job Corp; her daughters Pam married with 2 children, and Marie married with one child.

Ms. Anderson's Story is featured in the book "With the Power of Each Breath" a Disabled Women's Anthology's , she works with Access Living, she also worked with the late Mayor Harold Washington, breaking ground for the Polk Street Aging and Senior Citizens Building.

To some Rehabilitation is physical, to others it's in the mind.







